Bioenergy Markets for Europe - New Conference & Trade Fair in Brussels

Reutlingen, Sept. 01 st, 2009

With the growing importance of bioenergy in Europe, the European Biomass Association AEBIOM and the REECO Group have gathered together to organize an international trade fair and conference for bioenergy – RENEXPO® Bioenergy EUROPE & AEBIOM European Bioenergy Conference. It will take place on 30 June – 1 July 2010 at Albert Hall in Brussels, Belgium.

The REECO Group, trade fair and conference organizer with its headquarters in Germany, has recognized that the development and further promotion of bioenergy is an important task for Europe as a whole. After successful trade fairs and conferences in Germany and in Central and South East Europe on renewable energy, energy-efficient buildings and their refurbishment, REECO is now heading to the European capital - Brussels.

In this task REECO is cooperating with AEBIOM, the European Biomass Association, which will organize the AEBIOM European Bioenergy Conference. The conference will focus on current EU legislation and recent developments of bioenergy market in Europe as well as the state of the National Renewable Energy Action Plans. The event will serve as a platform for bioenergy market actors to exchange ideas and information as well as a discussion forum with policy makers. The main topics will cover the following issues: biomass supply, certification, biogas, biofuels, heating, electricity, financing bioenergy projects.

The premiere of RENEXPO® Bioenergy EUROPE will take place at the same time. Around 60 international exhibitors representing bioenergy/bioenergy technology producers and suppliers as well as experts from research and development, associations, media, governmental agencies and administrations are expected to participate in the trade fair. They will present their products, services and latest innovations to an estimated number of 1,200 visitors and 300 conference participants.

“The renewable energy directive has set ambitious objectives for 2020 for each member state of the European Union. Bioenergy, which represents 2/3 of renewables is expected to play a key role and its use should treble in the coming 10 years. All markets for heating/cooling, electricity and biofuels for transport are expected to increase significantly. Improved framework conditions and support schemes will create new bioenergy market opportunities, both for small and large companies.” – said Heinz Kopetz, President of AEBIOM.

The unique concept of the event, clearly defined goals and carefully selected location in the heart of Europe together with the cooperation of two experienced European partners are the guarantee for the success of the new, trend setting, European bioenergy platform.
